Requirements:

Ph.D. in philosophy; AOS or AOC in epistemology or philosophy of mind. Solid teaching experience. No prior knowledge of German is required. Teaching and administrative duties can be carried out in English.

Expectations:

<u>Teaching:</u> 7SWS, i.e. 7 hours a week.

The suggested division of courses is as follows: 3 courses in the Summer Semester 2021 (3 topic courses in epistemology) and 4 courses in the Winter Semester 2021 (introduction to philosophy seminar, epistemology lecture and 2 seminars on a topic of his/her choice).
